
Halloween Best Dressed and **Best Dressed House Competition**

Catherine Park House is steeped in a varied and fascinating past. The lands surrounding the country manor have historically been used for pastoral and farming purposes. In the 1940s-60s, the grounds were converted into a trotting track, golf course and function centre, and Catherine Park House was used as the golf clubhouse. It even housed an internationally renowned collection of vintage Lotus racing cars in the 1970s. According to urban legend, the late Princess Diana stayed at Catherine Park House during her visit to Australia in 1985.
