

WINS PRESTIGIOUS NATIONAL INDUSTRY AWARD



Catherine Park Estate has been crowned Australia's best residential subdivision in the prestigious national industry award given by the Urban Development Institute of Australia (UDIA).

To be considered for the national award, Catherine Park won the NSW Award late last year. Other state winners from around the country were also in the running with Catherine Park victorious.

The judges of the award commenting on the win said that the "attention to detail is apparent, and the developers are to be commended for doing density differently and raising the bar for industry and consumers alike.

"Catherine Park emphatically demonstrates the developer's commitment to creating a sustainable development with authentic community building initiatives. Creating a legacy residential project requires patience and attention to detail, both of which Harrington Estates have demonstrated admirably.

VISION REALISED

The vision of Sir Warwick Fairfax and Lady (Mary) Fairfax for Harrington Park was the creation of an idyllic estate that would accommodate a flourishing and vibrant community. Harrington Park started in 1994 and is now complete vith 2,000 homes, a primary school, a shopping centre, and numerous parks and ovals.
2009
Harrington Grove started in 2009 and now includes approximately 1,500 homes with large lots ranging from 700 m² to 5510 m². It will soon be complete when The Stables precinct is fully subscribed.
2015
Catherine Park Estate was officially launched in 2015 and includes approximately 1,750 dwellings, of which about 1,200 have been delivered to date.
